DEADLINES (Autumn Semester or full year)

Calls for Nomination From March 13th to May 13th 2024

Application deadline May 27th 2024*

*Students have to be nominated by you in order to be accepted.

CALENDAR

Autumn Semester: from September 2024 to January 2025*.

*We do not yet have the exact dates, which are usually published during the month of June by the Department of Education of the Generalitat de Catalunya.

Approximate starting dates are usually between 10 and 20 September, and finishing dates are between 15 and 25 January.

ERASMUS+ APPLICATION

Please, follow the application steps you can find on our <u>website</u>: and then select "How to Apply" in the menu on the left.

You must apply through the **form** and upload there the required documentation:

- Motivation letter in Spanish, Catalan or English (pdf).
- Personal Portfolio in Spanish, Catalan or English (pdf). A sample of the most outstanding projects you have carried out.
- Spanish Language certificate.
- English Language certificate.
- National identity card.
- European Health Insurance Card (or a private health insurance policy). More information
 on the website.

The last step is to fill out and sign the **Learning Agreement proposal on the EU Dashboard (OLA)**. You can find the ESDAPC curriculum on the web site:

LANGUAGE LEVEL and LANGUAGE COURSE

Our courses are all given in Spanish or in Catalan. So, if you can not certificate a B2 level of Spanish or Catalan, you can apply but understanding that you take the **compromise to follow our Spanish or Catalan course** in an external centre (for free). **This course is mandatory for those students who do not have a B2 certificate or higher of Spanish or Catalan**. In this case, you must include the subject "Spanish Language Course" (3 ECTS) or "Catalan language course" (3 ECTS) in your Learning Agreement proposal. If you have a good level in English and some basis in Spanish your application will still be taken into consideration.

On the other hand, if you do not have a B1 level of Spanish or Catalan, it is strongly recommended that you only choose **practical subjects and workshops**, not the theoretical ones.

TIMETABLE

Lesson time usually goes, Monday to Friday.

Depending on the campus where you are going to study, classes are held in the mornings (matí) or afternoons (tarda).

- from 08:00 a.m. until 14:30 p.m. (morning studies)
- from 15:00 p.m. until 21:30 p.m. (afternoon studies)
